1 Introduction

The local domain of the Policing Performance Assessment Framework provides an opportunity for the Metropolitan Police Authority to assess the performance of the Metropolitan Police Service in priority areas not covered by Statutory Performance Indicators. The local domain indicators must be outcome focused and have the ability to be graded on a poor/fair/good/excellent scale.

This document will explain what the contents of the Policing Performance Assessment Framework local domain will be and what our targets for these will be.

2 Contents of the Local Domain

Measure	The number of criminal networks disrupted
Description	A disruption can be claimed at any time in an operation if there is evidence that a criminal networks has been prevented from operating at previous levels for a significant time.
Target for 2006/07	150

Measure	The number of calls made to police regarding anti-social behaviour
Description	The 100 electoral wards within London that suffer from the highest volume of calls regarding anti-social behaviour will be expected to have a greater percentage reduction than the remaining 524 electoral wards.
Target for 2006/07	To be baselined due to changes made to the National Standards for Incident Reporting
